The B&E Burnie Ten's 5 kilometre event is a fun run. Because of its shorter distance, walkers, non-elite wheelchair and entrants with prams are encouraged to choose this event.

**Race bibs:** Race bibs must be clearly visible on the front of runner's chest. Race bibs will be mailed out if requested but will not after October 11. Entries received after this date need to collect their race bibs from Burnie City Council Offices, 80 Wilson Street prior to the race. Refer to [www.burnieten.com.au](http://www.burnieten.com.au) for opening hours. Race day entry and late bib collection should be made as early as possible on Sunday to ensure you make the start. These can be collected from Council Offices from 8am.

**Medical Aid:** Available on the course and at finish.

**Presentations:** On stage (presentation times are dependent on system analysis time).

**Race times:** Race times and positions will be posted at [www.burnieten.com.au](http://www.burnieten.com.au) and published in The Advocate on Monday 23 October 2017.

**Drinks:** Available en route at the "Powerade" Water Stations at approximately 3, 5 & 7 km marks and at the finish line.

**Toilets:** Multi Storey Car Park Marine Terrace  
 Burnie Surf Club  
 Bottom end of Wilson St (portables)  
 Beside Burnie City Council (portables)  
 4 & 6 km marks on course.

Any entrant crossing the finishing line without entering or without completing the full course may be subject to legal action. All entrants must stay in the right hand lane of the highway at all times. At the completion of the race, entrants should proceed to the recovery area immediately.

Bikes, roller skates, roller blades, inline skates, skate boards, scooters, performance enhancing devices and pets are not permitted.

For safety reasons non-elite and assisted wheelchair entrants, walkers and prams are advised to start at the rear of the field. At the discretion of Tasmania Police, the course will remain open as long as practically possible.

### Race Timing Declaration:

I understand event organisers will make every effort to provide a true and accurate time in accordance with IAAF rules. However in the event of a systems failure, or errors occurring, I agree not to hold event organisers liable. Any timing protests or objections must be lodged 72 hours after the race, after which race times will become official.

### Event Waiver Clause:

(1) I understand the demanding physical nature of the event and have trained accordingly. I am not aware of any medical condition or impairment that will be detrimental to my health if I participate in this event. In the chance that I become aware of any medical condition or impairment, or I am otherwise sick or injured prior to the event, I will withdraw from the B&E Burnie Ten.

(2) I acknowledge that participating in this event may involve a real risk of serious injury or even death from various causes including: over-exertion, dehydration and accidents with other participants, spectators or road users.

(3) I acknowledge that it is a condition of participating in this event that I do so at my own risk. I accept all risks and release the event organiser, its agents, affiliates, employees, members, sponsors, promoters, volunteers and any person or body, directly or indirectly associated with the event, from all claims, demands and proceedings arising out of or connected with my participation, or with the child's participation where I am signing this as parent/guardian in this event and I indemnify them against all liability for all injury, loss or damage arising out of or connected with my participation in this event. This release continues forever and binds my heirs, successors, executors, personal representatives and assigns.

(4) I acknowledge that if I am entering as a support aide of a disabled individual, I will take all possible care/precautions to not cause injury to the individual in my care, myself or any other competitors and I take full responsibility for actions associated with entering the B&E Burnie Ten. If the wheelchair or conveyancing device causes injury or loss to a third party, I agree to indemnify the Burnie City Council for any costs or loss that they may incur as a result. A support aide who has not paid the full entry fees, will not be classed as a competitor and is therefore not entitled to a race time, medallion or finish line gifts.

### Age Declaration:

I declare that I am over 18 years of age or the Parent/Guardian of the person entering who is under 18 years of age and give my consent to named person entering the event.

### Refund & re-issuing Policy:

I understand that due to administrative costs and associated race consumables refunds will not be issued. Re-issuing of a race bib will incur a \$10.00 fee.
